

'Scattered' Kaleidoscope Quilt Directions

Finished Size 37" X 37"

Materials Needed:

- * 12 Pre-Cut 5" Kaleidoscope Blocks
- * Focus Fabric (Outer Border) 1/2 Yard
- * Accent Fabric (Spacer Blocks & Inner Border) 3/4 Yard
- * Binding Fabric 1/3 Yard

(If you are using the same fabric for Accent Fabric & Binding Fabric, you only need a total of 1 Yard)

Step 1: Sew your 12 Kaleidoscope Blocks according to directions included, press and square to 5.5"

<u>Step 2</u>: From accent fabric, cut 2 strips at 5.5" X WOF, sub-cut into 13 5.5" squares, these will be your spacer blocks.




Fig. 1 Make 3

Step 3: Sew Kaleidoscope Blocks & Spacer Blocks into rows as shown in Fig 1., alternating blocks.




Fig. 1 Make 2

<u>Step 4:</u> Sew together your 5 rows from Step 3, referring to photo of quilt at top of this page, alternating rows as shown, you will end up with a approx. 25.5" square.

<u>Step 5</u>: Again from your accent fabric, cut 4 strips at 2.5" X WOF for inner border. Sub-cut 2 strips to 25.5" and sew to the top & bottom of quilt, sub-cut the remaining 2 strips to 29.5 and sew to both sides.

<u>Step 6:</u> From your focus fabric, cut 4 strips at 4" X WOF, Sub-cut 2 strips to 29.5" and sew to top & bottom, sub-cut remaining 2 strips to 36.5" & sew to both sides.

Step 7: Layer & Quilt as desired.

Step 8: Cut 4 binding strips at 2.5"xWOF and bind.
