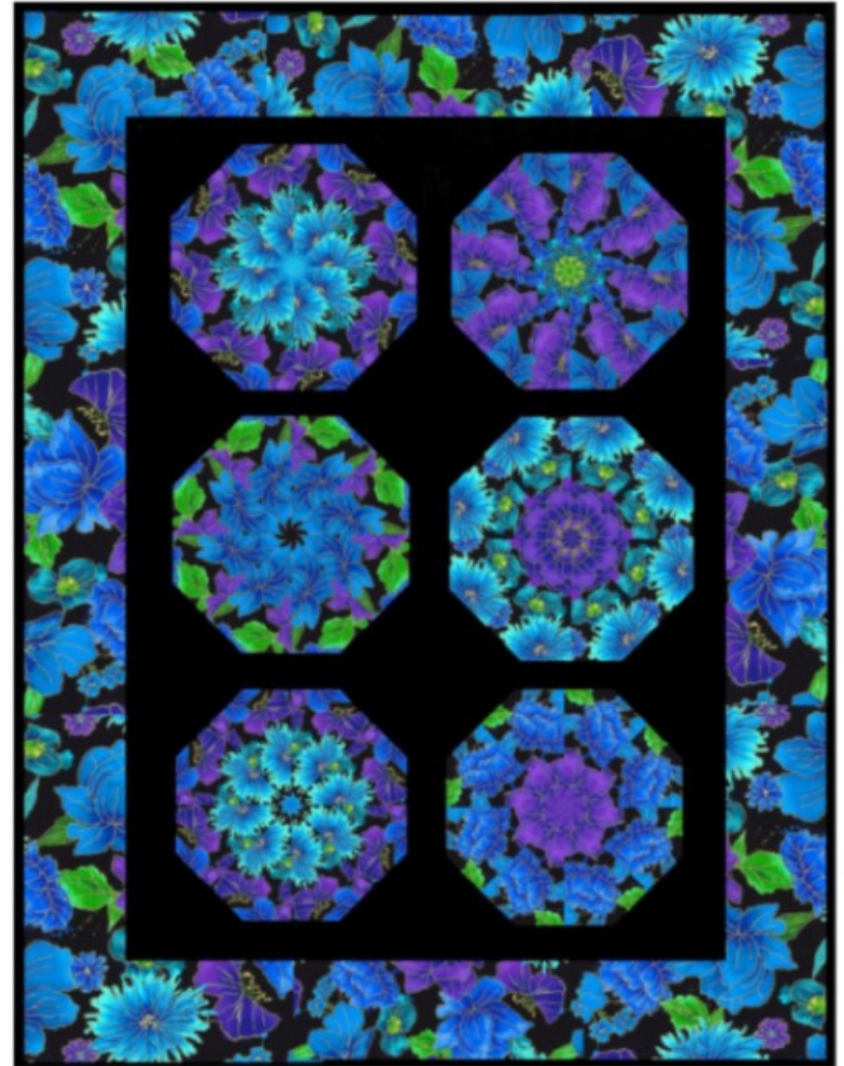

**** PLEASE READ DIRECTIONS THOROUGHLY
BEFORE BEGINNING****

Step 1: Basic Block Directions are included to construct your Kaleidoscope blocks, once you have constructed all six of your Kaleidoscope blocks, square each one to 10.5" (see Fig. 1)

Step 2: From the accent fabric, cut 6 strips at 2", using 4 of those 2" strips, subcut each into a 10.5" piece and a 22" piece. Using 3 of the 10.5" pieces as sashing, connect two blocks as shown in Fig. 2, make a total of 3 sets.

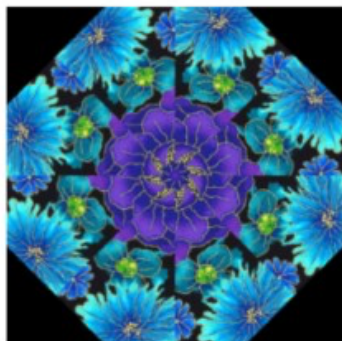

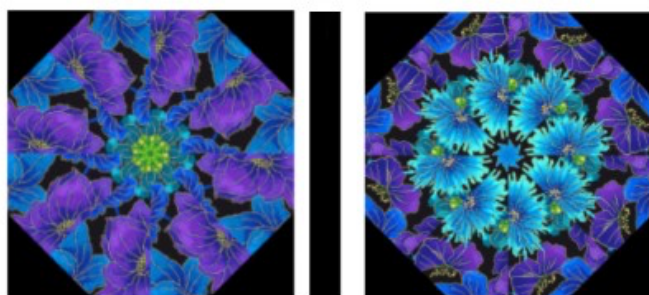
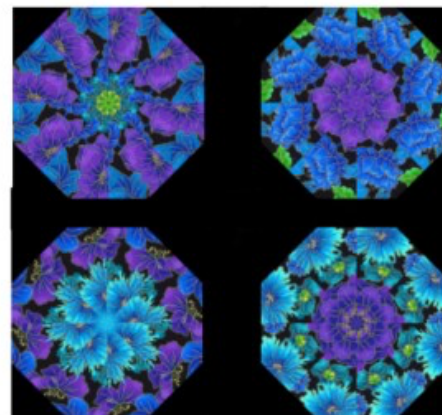

Step 3: Using the 4 22" pieces, now connect the sets of 2 blocks shown in Fig. 3, Then add one to the top and one to the bottom for the inner border, you will have 3 sets of 2 blocks,



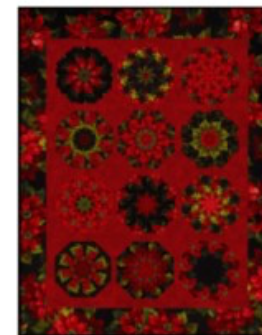
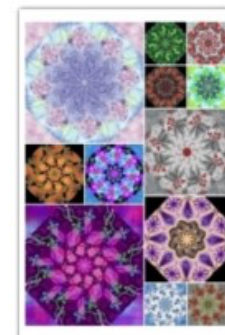
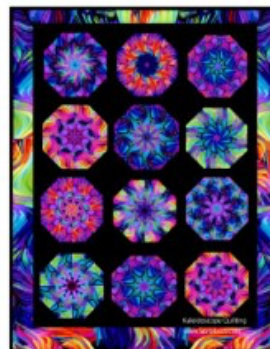
Step 4: Subcut the 2 remaining 2" strips to 36.5" and add these to the sides of the top to finish the inner border.

Step 5: From the Focus Fabric, cut 4 strips at 3.5", subcut 2 of the strips to 25" for the top and bottom outer border, then use remaining strips (and leftover pieces if needed) to make 2 - 42.5" pieces for the final side borders.

Step 6: Quilt as desired

Step 7: From the remaining accent fabric, cut 5 strips at 2.5" and bind your quilt.
