- \* 1/3 Yard Focus Fabric (outer border)

**\*\* PLEASE READ DIRECTIONS  
THOROUGHLY BEFORE BEGINNING \*\***

**Step 1** Basic block directions are included to construct your Kaleidoscope blocks, once you have constructed your three Kaleidoscope Blocks, square each to 10.5" (see [Fig. 1](#))

**Step 2** From accent fabric, cut a 2"x WOF strip, then sub-cut into 4 pieces sized at 2"x10.5". Sew one piece to the left side of each block (as shown by red arrows in [Fig. 2](#))

Then sew the three blocks together and then finally sew the remaining 2"x10.5" strip to the right side of the first block (as shown by green arrow in [Fig. 3](#)).

Iron as you sew. You will then have three kaleidoscope blocks with a sashing strip in between each block, and a strip on each end.

***Wasn't that so fun and easy, and yet so stunningly beautiful when complete!!***

**Step 3** From accent fabric, cut 2 more strips at 2" X WOF then sub-cut into 2 pieces at 36.5" and sew to top and bottom (the long edges). This will complete the inner border.

**Step 4** From focus fabric, cut 3 strips, 3" x WOF and sub-cut into 2 pieces 3" x 36.5" and again sew to top and bottom (the long edges), then sub-cut the last strip into 2 pieces 3" x 18.5" and sew to each end of table runner. Iron until smooth and laying flat.

**Step 5** Quilt as desired

**Step 6** From accent fabric, cut 3 strips at 2.5" x WOF and bind your runner.
