## 'Sliced' Kaleidoscope Table Runner

Finished Size $16^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$

*** Please read all directions before beginning, sew using a scant $1 / 4$ "

## Materials Needed:

* 3 Pre Cut 10" Kaleidoscope Blocks with corners.
* 1/3 Yard Accent Fabric (inner border \& sashing)
* 1/4 Yard Focus Fabric (outer border)
* 1/4 Yard Binding Fabric


## Cutting your fabric:

Accent Fabric: Cut 2- $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, subcut these into $8-3$ " $\times 8^{\prime \prime}$ pieces. Cut $4-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, subcut these into $2-$ $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 38.5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and $6-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces.
Focus Fabric: Cut 3-2.5"x WOF strips, subcut into $2-2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 42.5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and 2-2.5"x $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces.
Step 1: Sew your pre cut Kaleidoscope Blocks, if you have never made our Kaleidoscope Blocks, please refer to our website www.labfabrics.com and click the Pattern Downloads page for directions to complete your blocks. Block directions will be towards the bottom of the page. Sew one complete block adding all four corners and trim to $10.5^{\prime \prime}$ square (this will be your middle block of the runner). Sew the remaining 2 blocks, however once you get your half blocks, stop there, do not sew the halves together or add corners at this point. See Figure 1
Step 2: Sew 2 corners to each half block, you will sew the corners to the inner two wedges as shown in Figure 2. Sew one corner on, flip \& press, then add second corner, flip and press. Now you will need to trip each edge as shown in Figure 3.

Step 3: Now add a 3 " $x 8^{\prime \prime}$ piece of accent fabric to each edge you just trimmed, press open and you will have a block that looks like the block shown in Figure 4.


Step 4: Now to square up the half block. Fold your half block in half aligning fold on cutting mat as shown in Fig. 5, align ruler at $5.5^{\prime \prime}$ and trim the outer raw edge again as shown in Fig. 5. , open your block and check that is measures $10.5^{\prime \prime}$ long. Trim if needed to be $10.5^{\prime \prime}$. Now to trim the top edge, press your block to be sure it's nice and flat and align ruler $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from top of block as shown in Figure 6 and trim. You now have your completed half block, repeat for remaining 3 blocks.

Step 5: Sashing \& Borders—Sew a $1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 10.5^{\prime \prime}$ accent strip between each block and end blocks. Then sew all blocks together using picture of the runner at top of this page for reference and you now have your inner runner top. Now add the 1.5 " $\times 38.5^{\prime \prime}$ inner border accent strips to long edges, then add the $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$ focus fabric strips to ends then add the $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 42.5$ to long sides and you are done!!

Step 6: Quilt as desired and bind!!.
